- Prosecuted one of the early child sex abuse cases by a catholic priest who was represented by a former United States Attorney and a former first assistant district attorney in Dallas County, he was convicted and sentenced to 5 years in prison
- Assigned to juvenile division for two and a half years doing trials and certifications
- Prosecuted first internet sex crime in Dallas County
- Lectured law enforcement officers and prosecutors on how to present child sex abuse cases to a jury

- Visiting associate judge, 304<sup>th</sup> and 305<sup>th</sup> District Courts of Dallas County, courts specializing in juvenile cases
- First chair qualified for death penalty cases in the First Administrative Judicial Region
